**Minutes : 9<sup>th</sup> February 2012**

**22.01 Apologies** – none received

**22.02 Declarations of Interest** – Cllr Dawson declared an interest, as neighbour, to applications PA12/00478, PA12/00479, PA12/00494 and PA12/00495

Cllr Ferrett stated “following the meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> January, and the discussion of Standing Orders specific to Forrabury & Minster Parish Council, the Council should cease recording meetings until such Standings are adopted. In the meantime the Parish council will continue operating to the Model Standing Orders”. Cllr Jarvis proposed the council accept Cllr Ferretts statement. Seconded by Cllr Smith. All in favour. **Resolved.**

**22.03 Public Participation** – 4 members of the public present

B3263 Drainage – Mr Steege asked the Council to focus its efforts to ensure the drainage issue is satisfactorily resolved. The clerk read out an email from Cornwall Council advising of their proposed plan which would involve 4-5 night time of road closure around mid-March.  
Valency River Management – Mr Steege asked what is happening as the trees need to be cut before the end of March. The Clerk and Cllr Findlay met with the EA tree survey officer and others on 19<sup>th</sup> January and are awaiting his report.

Planning applications PA12/00478 & PA12/00479 – Mrs Manning asked if all Councillors had received a copy of her statement to the Council and if they had read it. The councillors all stated they had read a copy. Mrs Manning added further comments to the statement. Polqueens was bought as a second home and hope to live there in the future. The current situation with the works is unsafe for the grandchildren to play in the garden. She requested the council, please, consider all the facts and take them into consideration when considering the application.
