**08.01 Apologies** – Cllr Findlay, Cornwall Cllr Brown , *CLLR DAWSON. DJH*

**08.02 Declarations of Interest** – Cllr Ferrett declared a non prejudicial interest in planning application PA12/08013.

**08.03 Public Participation** – 4 members of the public present

Highways - A member of the public observed that it appears one of the recently installed chevron on the hairpin bend is pointing the wrong way. In addition the one way signs in Fore Street, Dunn Street and Old Road had been replaced but the one opposite Gunpool Lane is still missing.

Another member of the public highlighted that the drainage problem on the B3263 has reappeared. Clerk to raise these issues with highways.

Street lighting - dimming project had the Parish Council had any correspondence form Cornwall Council re the project for Boscastle as Crackington had received a programme of street light dimming? The Clerk has received no communication form Cornwall Council on this topic.

Valency River Management - does the Parish Council think they should be involved in the Valency River Management Plan? The Council considers it should have an interest and would discuss further at next meeting.

Recycling – with the new collection receptacles placing recycling directly on the road outside properties with no frontage can cause a traffic hazard, particularly as when emptied they continue to be there, (unlike the previous bag system) until taken in they remain a potential hazard.

Clerk to raise concerns with Cornwall Council.

Football Club – Cllr Brewer read out the recent press release which confirmed ~~the~~ <sup>50% DJH</sup> funding for the new changing facility had been secured.
