## **11.04 Planning**

### **A) To consider planning applications received (none received for agenda)**

Proposal	Proposed 250KW ground mounted solar installation comprising 8 rows of panels, 1 x 100m, 2 x 80m, 2 x 60m and 3 x 40m, all approximately 2.8m wide
Location	Land East of Trevilla Park, Slaughterbridge, Camelford, Cornwall

## **11.05 Boscastle CP School**

Councillors discussed the make-up of the governing body and the benefits federation would bring to Boscastle School. Cllr Chater proposed the Council support the federation with Port Isaac School. Seconded by Cllr Haddy. All in favour. **Resolved.**

## **11.06 Royal British Legion**

Cllr Smith requested this item be included for this meeting, however in his absence the council without an understanding of the issues held this over to the next meeting. Whilst discussing the up and coming Remembrance Day was considered and the Clerk report that the War Memorial would be tidied ahead of the day and asked if bark chippings should be used after weeding. ## **11.07 Highways**

Penally Hill – This area of highway from the Car Park entrance up the hill is regularly used (outside the current parking restriction period) for parking. The Council considered with the high number of vehicles doing so, it restricted visibility for vehicles exiting adjoining properties, use of the garages extremely difficult and restricted the width of the highway.
