11.04 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 11th September 2014 - Cllr Hockin proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record. Seconded by Cllr Irving-Little. All in favour. **Resolved.**

Minutes of the meeting held on 28th August 2014 - Cllr Irving-Little proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record. Seconded by Cllr Martin. All in favour. Cllr Chater abstained not at meeting. **Resolved.**

11.06 Items from previous meeting

Highway Issues including Rubbish – reported that rubbish is around the skateboard ramp. Cllr Irving-Little proposed the council obtain a price for a wall mounted bin. Seconded by Cllr Hockin All in favour. **Resolved.** Cllr Hocking proposed the council implement via signs ‘No dogs on playing field’ Seconded by Cllr Chater. All in favour. **Resolved.**

The highway site meeting held at very short notice to discuss New Road enabled the councillors who could attend to ask plenty of questions, with no resolution or any changes to what had been put forward. Cllr Clarke proposed the council request another meeting with at least 10 days’ notice. Seconded by Cllr Rodda. All in favour. **Resolved.**

Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – Clerk reported the fund is being calculated and a figure would be advised at the end of October.

Parish Plan – Nothing Further to report.

Castle Site – The transfer of the site to the Parish Council will require a solicitor for the conveyancing. Cllr Rodda proposed the council approach Chris keys to see if he would represent and if so the likely costs. Seconded by Cllr Hockin. All in favour. The council to ask Cornwall council for the site to be handed over in good heart with benches and tables in a good state of repair and fit for purpose.

Stone Welcome Signs – Cllr Ferrett has talked with a builder who may be willing to install the signs.

Works around the village – The vegetation at the bottom of Forrabury Hill, requires cutting back as a safety point of view. The pavement from Doctors Hill to Barnpark cannot be used due to brambles. Cllr Irving-Little proposed the Council ask M.Smith to trim the pavement and around the bend on the opposite side of the road. Seconded by Cllr Hockin. All in favour. **Resolved.** Cllr Irving-Little reported that the hairpin bend at the bottom of new Road would
