Highway Issues including Rubbish – Clerk showed the council the new dog fouling signs and would arrange for their installation. Cllr Irving-Little advised the council that she would open the car park gates tomorrow for the half term period.

Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – The clerk read out an email copied to him by the BCTC regarding the Parish fund which states Andy Brown of Cornwall Council is dealing and aims to have the funds with the council by the end of the month.

Parish Plan – No further information - meeting next week to review progress so far.

Castle Site – No further response from Cornwall Council. Clerk to chase.

Stone Welcome Signs – Nothing further to report. Cllr Smith would look at slate with Glenton Brown.

Works around the village – Cllr Ferrett expressed how much better New Road is after being clered.

Seat Green Lane/Paradise – Progressing, seat to be repaired and installed near Windrush.

Ceramic poppies – The clerk has now received the 23 ceramic poppies. To date there are 9 proposed sponsors, councillors discussed methods of displaying - no firm decision reached.

Neighbourhood Development Plan – Cllr Rodda reported that Cornwall Council has put a local plan to the Secretary of State which may provide some basic detail. A roadshow will be set up by Cornwall Council later in the year. Unless there is a formal local plan then the inference is for development. Cllr Rodda would continue to investigate and push Cornwall Council for more information.

18.07 Items since last meeting

National pay review for council clerks – the clerk reported the recent salary agreement by the National Joint Council for Local Government Services, which a) increases clerk salary by 28p per hour and b) provides a non-consolidated pay award of £83.20 in lieu of 2014 pay award. Cllr Martin proposed the increase of 28p be accepted. Seconded by Cllr Smith. All in favour.
