Minutes : 11<sup>th</sup> June 2015

**04.01 Apologies** – Cllr Smith, Cllr Irving-Little

**04.02 Declarations of Interest** – Cllr Jarvis declared an interest in planning application PA15/04343.

**04.03 Public Participation** – 9 members of the public present. A member of the public outlined their reasons against planning application PA15/04343.

A member of the public raised concern over the interaction between councillors and a member of the public at the last meeting.

A member reported that their property had again been damaged by vehicles using New Road, and pointed out that highways signs have also been damaged by vehicles.

**04.04 Minutes**

Minutes of the meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2015 - Cllr Martin proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record. Seconded by Cllr Chater. All in favour. **Resolved.**

**04.05 Matters to report (only) from previous meetings minutes**

**04.06 Items from previous meeting**

Highway Issues including Rubbish – Cllr Martin reported the camber in Langford Meadow has altered following the recent resurfacing which inhibits surface water accessing the gutters. Clerk to report to Cornwall Council. New Road Cornwall council should have cut the hedge but this has not been done. Clerk to write to Cornwall Council and insist this action and some suitable steps are taken to alleviate the damage to listed buildings.

Camelford Road crossroad junction at Venn Down, another recent accident. Clerk to write to Highways for better signage at the junction.

Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – Cllr Chater reported the agreement regarding the fund is still awaited. Toilet times appear to still be set at 1700. Clerk to report. Cllr Jarvis proposed the council write a letter to Cornwall Council re parking charges during the festival weekend. Seconded by Cllr Hockin. All in favour. Resolved.

Parish Plan – Cllr Jarvis outlined the progress of the plan and introduce Johnathon Stirrup who completed a draft report. The chair suspended standing orders to enable Mr Stirrup to outline the draft document. The Councillor expressed their thanks for the work done.

Castle Site – The clerk advise on the current situation regarding the transfer of ownership. Following the last meeting and the documentation received it appear that the decision not to have searches has raised more questions. Cllr Rodda proposed that given the new information the Council request searches be done. Seconded by Cllr Jarvis. All in favour. Resolved.

Cllr Hockin proposed the land value be set at £1. Seconded by Cllr Martin. All in favour.

Resolved. Cllr Hockin proposed the clerk be the address for service at land registry. Seconded by Cllr Rodda. All in favour. Resolved.
