Dear Stakeholder

You may have heard through local events or staff meetings about the nation-wide requirement for groups of NHS and social care organisations to develop a local Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP).

Please find attached a summary of our work so far on the Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) for Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly. Please circulate within your organisation as appropriate.

The STP is required by NHS England to achieve three aims set out in the NHS Five Year Forward View that was published in October 2014:

- Improve the health and wellbeing of the local population.
- Improve the quality of local health and care services.
- Deliver financial stability in the local health and care system.

All health and care partners (NHS and councils) are taking the opportunity to work together to design a more integrated system with one plan and one budget that puts the individual citizen first, rather than organisations or buildings.

We know that the current system is stretched and needs to be able to meet the needs of citizens and communities as well as to be financially sustainable. This may be a once in a generation opportunity to transform local health and care services.

Our common aim is to focus more resources on preventing ill health and keep people as healthy as possible for as long as possible and out of hospital. We all want services that are high quality, co-ordinated and cost-effective.

Many of our clinicians, practitioners and managers are already working on ideas and options to improve the quality of care and ensure sustainability. Please read the document attached and look out for opportunities and events to get involved in shaping the future of local services.
