Present: Chairman Clr Ferrett, Clrs Brewer, Hockin, Jarvis, Findlay, Day, Irving-Little, Rodda and Smith.

- 07.01 Apologies:** Clr Dawson, Clerk Bob Smith and Cornwall Councillor Glenton Brown.
- 07.02 Public Participation:** Lack of transparency between FMPC and residents queried. Facts do not support this view. Village Hall/ Sure Start questions (see agenda item 8) Responsibility for gardening in the car park rests with Cornwall Council.
- 07.03 Steve Besford-Foster (Localism Area Manager East)** explained the principle of Active Partnering and how it might be applied to us on such items as Castle site maintenance car park management/revenue. Steve and Chris Sims answered questions. Further consideration required.
- 07.04 Receive and Confirm Minutes 8th July 2010:** were rejected for lack of perceived items.
- 07.05 Matters for Report:** Surgery notice board to be placed on redundant toilet wall facing the car park.
- 07.06 Shippen Roadworks:** FMPC hopes that the two week trial is successful thus saving the inconvenience of a full diversion. Failing this FMPC hope that Highways will consult with them to consider traffic lights. Clr Findlay proposed a meeting with Angela Holmes to walk the route with Parish Councillors and traders, seconded by Clr Rodda, all in favour, Resolved.
- 07.07 SW Water:** Clr Jarvis reported system up and running for a two week proving period. Noise levels appear to be operating legally. Odour at slip road near Janet Lathams property will be reported by Clr Jarvis. Clr Brewer proposed letter to SW Water requesting information on noise and odour levels, seconded by Clr Jarvis, all in favour, Resolved.
- 07.08 Village Hall:** Michael Parsons informed the meeting that NCH no longer exists. The Village Hall committee are going to notify the relevant body about the playgroup withdrawal. There is no implication to the Parish Council.
- 07.09 Planning applications:** None, however Clr Brewer raised the matter of missed Trerosewill consultation. Clr Rodda suggested discussing it in camera at the end of the meeting.
- 07.10 Cornwall Councillors Report:** none.
- 07.11 Correspondence:** Clrs Rodda and Jarvis will attend the Network Management meeting on the 14th of September 2010.
