11.06 Items from previous meeting

War Memorial – A membrane covered with slate chippings has now be put in place to tidy up the ground to the rear of the garden. Cllrs Ferrett & Findlay will discuss planting with the school.

What's important to the Community – So far 45 responses to the questionnaire have been received. Cllr Rodda attended a meeting about setting a parish plan, however it transpired the event was more about areas of natural beauty rather than an overall view of writing a plan. Other similar parish council are using the questionnaire approach to seek community views and concerns.

Highway Issues – The clerk continues to chase Cornwall Council particularly B3266 flooding, water leak in Penally Hill and New Road drainage. Clerk is also attempting to arrange a site meeting with Cornwall Highways to reinforce the Parish Councils concerns. Cllr Dawson reported that a number of options have been considered to help reduce the risk of vehicles damaging properties in New Road, however these would potentially cause some element of flood risk. Removing/amending the parking order maybe a consideration. Cllr Dawson asked to be included in the agenda for the next meeting.

Small Works around the village – As agreed at meeting on 1st November, clerk to place an advert in local publications.

Castle Site – Cllr Rodda has applied to Cornwall Council for permissive path to link castle site with NT footpaths on other side of river. Awaiting response.
