Highways – Could consideration be given to the area of ground, on the opposite side of the road to the old toilets by the doctors surgery, to create an area of parking to replace that which will be lost when the development of the old toilets takes place. Clerk to raise with Cornwall Council.

Pavements - the pavements on both sides of the road from Doctors corner to Potters Lane are green with algae and pose a slipping hazard to pedestrians. Clerk to inform Cornwall Council.

B3266 – the road is again flooding after rain. Clerk to contact Cornwall Council.

Car Park – the car park is flooding on grass section, probably from the adjacent stream. Clerk to contact Cornwall Council.

Highway Issues – The clerk to continue to chase the Council on B3266 flooding, water leak in Penally Hill and New Road drainage. Clerk to also request a copy of the gully cleaning schedule. Cllr Dawson also brought the council up to date with the utilities road works on new road and the RTC incident where Mr & Mrs Mannings Property was damaged by a coach negotiating the restricted carriageway
