06.03 Public Participation – 3 members of the public present

Boscastle Car Park – when is the planting and the landscaped areas going to be tended to, as it is looking very uncared for. Clerk to write to Cornwall Council.

Trees - If a member of the public has, in their view, trees in a dangerous condition on their property and following a planning application which is refused, who is liable if the trees cause damage or injury. Clerk to clarify with Cornwall Council.

One Way Signs – The one way road from Doctors (Fore Street, Dunn Street and Old Road) is missing the appropriate one way signs. Clerk to ask Highways to reinstate.

Skateboarding down Penally Hill – individuals advised by member of public the dangers and Headmistress of School inform, perhaps it would be a good idea to include an activity area for teenagers in the Parish Plan.

New Road Victorian Villas - The guttering to a house in New Road has been damaged by vehicles twice in the last two months and on numerous occasions over the previous years. The owners have reported it to Highways, listed building and the Police.

Flood Plan – Cllr Irving Little has produced some items for inclusion in the Car park noticeboard. In light of the recent weather the Clerk to obtain a price for sandbags.

Traffic Calming – the clerk reported that Highways will identify and position post for the temporary traffic monitor, which will record traffic movement and speeds. Clerk to write to highways to request the rumble strips at the entrances to the village be repaired and the yellow lines on Penally Hill still need to be reinstated.
