07.02 Declarations of Interest – None Received

Paul Allen – Network Manager Cormac Solutions, gave the council some detail concerning the devolution of Public Conveniences in the County. Cornwall Council is seeking to make savings on the running cost of Public Conveniences by offering a grant to Parish and Town Councils toward the local management of the facilities. It currently cost Cornwall Council approx. £19,992 to operate the public toilets in the car park. The grant offered to Forrabury & Minster Council is £15,263. The Council will discuss this further at the next meeting.

07.03 Public Participation – 3 members of the public present

Boscastle Car Park – when is the planting and the landscaped areas going to be tended to, as it is looking very uncared for. Cllr Irving Little, following a meeting with highways officer, advised that the area is the responsibility of Cornwall Council Highways and the Parish Council has asked for a programme of works.

One Way Signs – The one way road from Doctors (Fore Street, Dunn Street and Old Road) is missing the appropriate one way signs. Cornwall Council Highways have been made aware on at least two occasions. Clerk to chase progress.
