15.04 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 12th December 2013 - Cllr Hockin requested a minor alteration to item Royal British Legion - '*Cllr Hockin reported that membership is now up to 31 members*'. Highway Issues – Cllr Martin raised the issue of an increased number of pot holes along Langfords Meadow. Councillors also noted ones in Green Lane, Under Road, and on the main road out of the village towards the Farm Shop.

Cllr Rodda raised concern about poor drainage in Fore Street following the recent heavy rain, blockages in the culvert drains either side of the road causing water to flood across the road. Cllrs discussed various points around the village prone to flooding.

Councillors would like the clerk to set up a meeting with Joe Parish of the Environment Agency to discuss the flood plan and flood issues within the community.

Public Convenience/Car Park – Cllrs would like to meet with the Boscastle Chamber of Trade and Commerce (BCTC) to discuss this matter. Cllr Jarvis proposed the clerk sets up a meeting. Seconded by Cllr Clarke. All in Favour **Resolved.**

Parish Plan – Cllr Rodda reports that plans are still being returned, over 200 back so far. Cllr Clarke reported that was a good return. Further developments will be reported at the next meeting.

Activity Equipment – Cllr Chater will update the council at the next meeting, no news to report at this meeting.

EA Open Meeting & Flood Plan – Cllrs would request the clerk send copies of the flood plan as discussed last meeting to the councillors.
