07.02 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Ferrett declared an interest in planning application PA14/06312.

07.03 Public Participation – 6 members of the public present

The agent for planning application PA14/05655 (discussed in July) outlined the rationale for the application (erection of wind turbine), 3 exist within the near vicinity, this turbine will feed directly into Hunter Stoves producing electricity for the complex.

Chairman of the Football Club raised concerns about parking space with the skateboard ramps location. Dog fouling on the football pitch is a real problem, and if signs could be produced the club would put up.

Applicant for planning application PA14/06312 stated that all neighbours within 1000m of the proposed wind turbine had been consulted and only one objected.
