14.02 Declarations of Interest – Cllr Martin declared an interest in planning application PA14/10546.

14.03 Public Participation - nothing other than input during agenda item 14.04

14.04 Residents and owners of properties in New Road to have the opportunity to raise their concerns regarding parking, traffic management and reducing risk of damage to properties.

Points raised by the public:-

- Parking to be kept during winter months
- Traffic management slow the speed to provide road safety especially for pedestrians
- Reduce risk of damage to properties
- Parking throughout the year
- No allowance for pedestrians
- Maintain parking to enable residents to lead a normal life
- No allowance for elderly or infirm residents
- Priority to either up or down vehicle movement
- Some form of protection
- Don't want to lose parking but to gain something
- The proposal the Parish council put forward has been completely ignored by Cornwall Council highways

CCllr Brown outlined the financial position of Cornwall Council and recognized the feeling of the public present.

Next steps – Mr Allen took away all the correspondence the Parish Council had received and would consider it and review the feasibility study report.

The Clerk outlined the Parish Council view and that this is part of a wider traffic management concerns that the council are trying to address around the village and it planned if possible to amalgamate any and all changes into a single traffic regulation order. The traffic regulation order fee regardless of size is £4000 before the cost of signs etc.
