#### **17.06 Items from previous meeting**

Highway Issues including Rubbish – Clerk showed the council proposed signs and the prices for no dog fouling. Cllr Smith proposed the council purchase 6 of each. Seconded by Cllr Martin. All in favour. **Resolved.**

Concern was raised that the potholes around the village have still not be filled. Cllr Irving-Little advised that this work is planned for 16<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> February.

Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – After discussion on possible future scenarios which may occur depending on Cornwall Councils long term plans, Cllr Jarvis proposed an informal meeting with the Boscastle Chamber of Trade and Commerce be arrange. Seconded by Cllr Chater. All in favour. **Resolved.** A provision date of 22<sup>nd</sup> January was set.

Parish Plan – A meeting in February is planned by the steering group to review the precis of the information obtained and determine any future analysis.
