Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – Cllr Chater reported back from the small team reviewing the public toilet situation. They are considering the option of setting up a charitable trust to manage the toilets. The Parish Council received a letter today(12th March) from Cornwall Council stating that from 1st April 2016 there will be no funding for public toilets.

Parish Plan – meeting planned for near Easter to review the information extracted and then to proceed with analysis extraction potential cost of this is £1000. After this it will be printing the plan.

Castle Site – No further response from Cornwall Council. Clerk to continue chasing.

Stone Welcome Signs – Nothing further to report. Cllr Smith not at meeting

Works around the village – Dog fouling signs in place, seat on grass triangle near paradise installed.

Seat Green Lane/Paradise – Seat now in place and ready for use.

Ceramic poppies – Cllr Ferrett reported he had received 6 sponsors for poppies and hopes another 6 will come forward. Cllr Ferrett asked if he could display them in a glass cabinet as part of the archive opening during Easter. Cllr Hockin proposed this would be okay so long as they remained under lock and key.
