#### **06.05 Matters to report (only) from previous meetings minutes**

The clerk reported on the outcome of the notice for a co-opted councillor, two persons have expressed an interest. The Clerk will arrange a meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> July for the council to meet them and appoint a suitable candidate.

#### **06.06 Items from previous meeting**

Highway Issues including Rubbish – Cllr Martin raised the ongoing need for yellow lines at near the doctors surgery entrance. It was noted that overgrowth is impacting on the highway near doctors corner from the site of the old doctors house.

Camelford Road crossroad junction at Waterpit/Venn Down, another recent accident. Clerk had written and reported on the response. Council dismayed this is not considered a dangerous junction, Clerk to re-write to Highways for better signage at the junction and re-emphasise the danger.

Parish Fund (car park & toilets) – Cllr Chater reported the agreement regarding the fund is still awaited.

Parish Plan – Cllr Jarvis outlined the progress of the plan and the draft shown at last meeting is now the final copy. An introduction has been drafted comparing how the village was 50 years ago against how it is today.

Castle Site – Nothing further to report, awaiting search results for solicitor. Cllr Rodda is investigating if grant aid possible from Paths for Communities and other sources.

Stone Welcome Signs – progressing sign writing in progress.

Works around the village – Clerk reported on meeting with Cornwall Council car park supervisor, who was shocked by its state. He will undertake to arrange the necessary repairs to the barrier fencing and he was quite happy for the parish council to maintain the planting areas between the toilets and Cornish stores also the area between the Spar shop and the
