10.01 Apologies – Cllr Smith, CCllr Brown

10.02 Declarations of Interest – none raised, however Cllrs Irving-Little and Jarvis both declared an interest in an item raised under matters to report.

10.03 Public Participation – 6 members of the public present

A member of the public advised the council that the rubbish bin in the Harbour had been removed. Cornwall Council waste collection contractor had decided not to empty bins on private land. The National Trust is proposing to install two new bins. The Council was also asked to have, when dealing with planning applications, thoughts for the future rather than the now.

Mr Davey raised objections to planning application PA15/07854 and asked the council to postpone any decision until himself and others had chance to consider the application further and didn't think a fair decision could be reached without visiting site. An previous application for the site had been refused and he is awaiting official documentation as to why the previous application was refused. He thanked those councillors who had visited site, and the development as proposed would have a significant impact on Hunters Rise.

Sue Walters representing the applicants for application PA15/07854 indicated that the drawing submitted were accurate, the development would be sympathetic to the area with timber and slate finish in recognition of it being in an AONB, it would be three bedrooms of approximately 100sq floor area.

10.04 Minutes

Minutes of the meeting held on 13th August 2015 - Cllr Chater proposed the minutes be accepted as a true record. Seconded by Cllr Martin. All in favour. **Resolved.**

Minutes of the meeting held on 3rd September 2015 - Cllr Hockin proposed the minutes be accepted without the amendment and signed at next meeting. Seconded by Cllr Chater. 7 in favour, 1 objection.

10.05 Matters to report (only) from previous meetings minutes

Cllr Hockin reported on Community Wind Turbine; he had meet the developer and things were looking favourable with discussions ongoing with land owner, any income that could come to the community would be low than predicted as the Government grants had been reduced.

The Clerk raised an email he had received concerning previous meeting planning application PA15/07099. Cllr Jarvis and Irving-Little recognising the application declared an interest and left the meeting. The email asked the Council to either accepted planning officers decision, agree to disagree or maintain their support for the application. Cllr Martin proposed the council maintain its support for the application. Seconded by Cllr Hockin. 5 in Favour, 1 against. Resolved. Cllrs Jarvis and Irving-Little re-joined the meeting.
